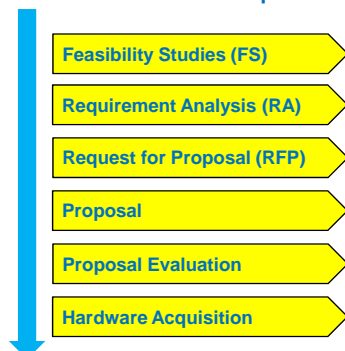

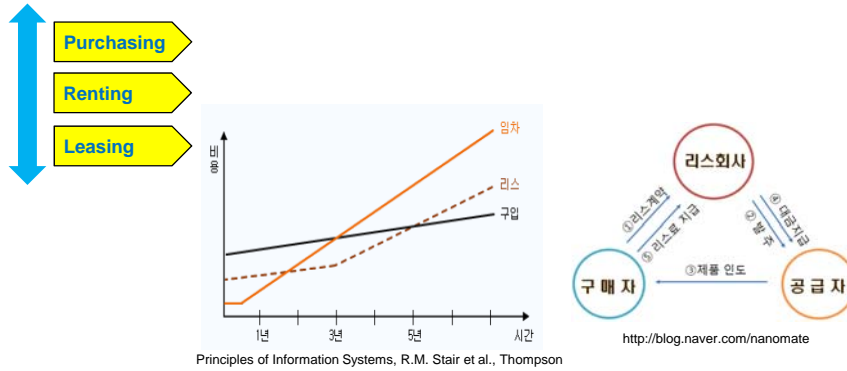
### Procedure of Hardware Acquisition of Management Information Systems

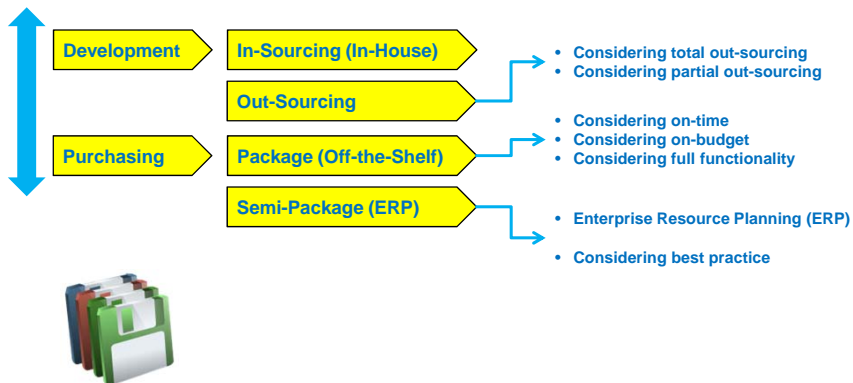
