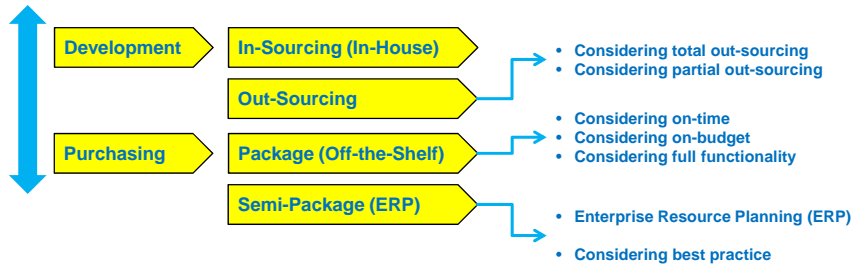

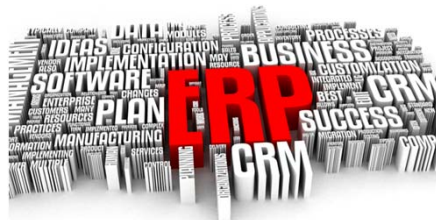

 - = A series of applications designed to bring business functions into balance and represents the next generation of systems

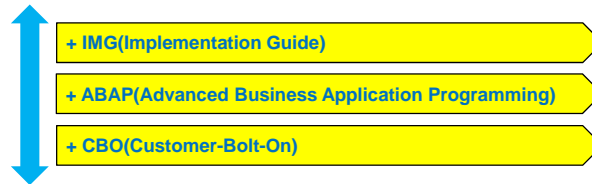

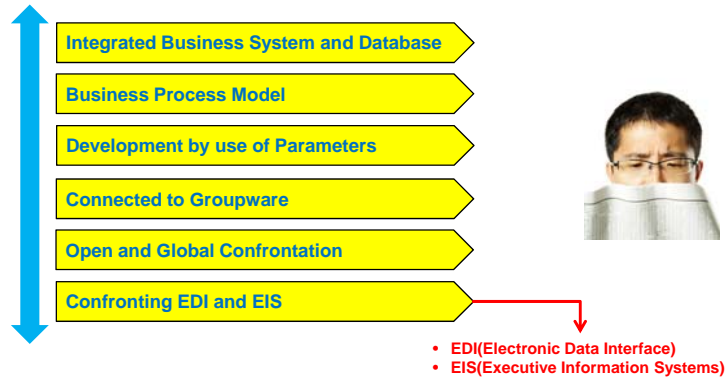

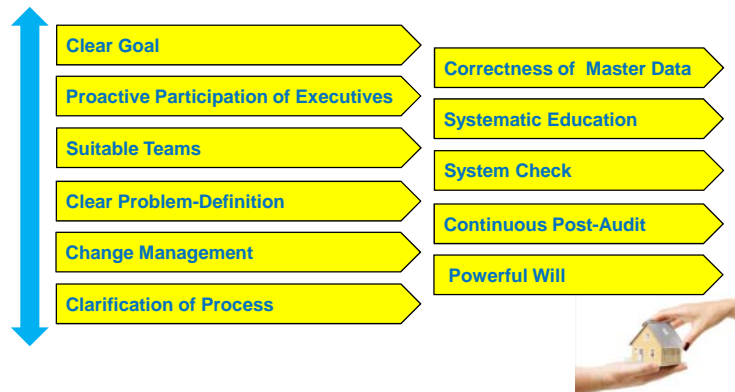

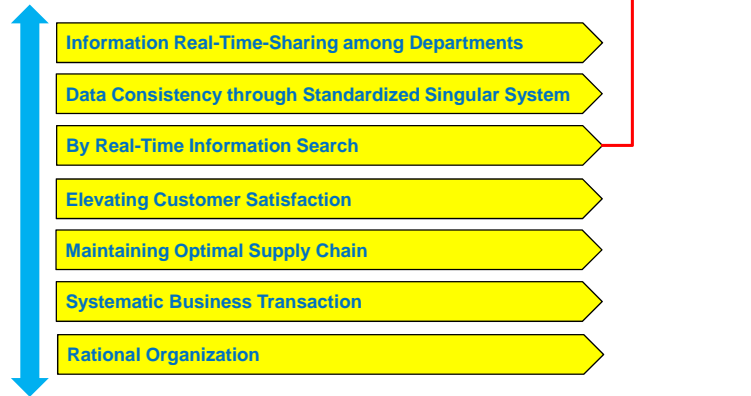
